The Rangitoto Island Historic Conservation Trust manages the Museum Bach at Rangitoto Wharf. The Museum represents 100 years of the island's architectural and social history with the involvement of more than 130 baches which were once scattered around the island. The museum is open to the public on weekends from Labour Weekend to Easter. However, we are happy to open outside of these hours for interested groups. Groups of 10 – 20 are welcome to visit the Museum for morning tea and hear about the history of the island baches.

Only 15 minutes from downtown Auckland or 10 minutes from Devonport via Fullers Ferries.

Confident walking skills are recommended as the paths and roads are scoria based.

The Museum is situated at the end of the Rangitoto Wharf.

Fees are \$10 person (with a minimum fee of \$100).
